Routine appointments may be booked online for doctor.

REPEAT PRESCRIPTIONS

Please allow 48 hours (2 full working days). Requests for repeat prescriptions are only accepted in writing. In order to avoid errors we are unable to take requests on the phone.

ELECTRONIC PRESCRIPTION SERVICE (EPS)

We are able to electronically send prescriptions to your nominated pharmacy. This will save you time and travel in having to go to two places.

ONLINE REPEAT PRESCRIPTIONS

It is now possible to order repeat prescriptions online.
48 hours notice will still be required.
